[2] Financial underwriting and public benefit standards	§570.203/204 activities must be evaluated following guidelines at §570.209 and Appendix A to Part 570; §570.209(b) <i>mandatory public benefit standards</i> apply, and also to §570.201(c) ED public facilities projects.		
[3] CDBG status of the assisted private for-profit business	A <i>beneficiary</i> (p. 1-8, <i>Managing CDBG: Subrecipient Oversight</i> , 3/2005); not a <i>subrecipient</i> or <i>contractor</i> ; not subject to Uniform Administrative Requirements or Section 3. Part 58 and Davis-Bacon apply.		
[4] HUD definition of microenterprise	Sec. 807(c)(2) of the HCDA of 1992: "a commercial enterprise that has five or fewer employees, one or more of whom owns the enterprise." Eligible assistance includes financial support, technical assistance, and general support. Subject to Uniform Administrative Requirements. A "small business" not qualifying as a <i>microenterprise</i> may be assisted under §570.203(b), generally for job creation or retention (LMJ).
